HE IS A SYMPATHETIC GOD

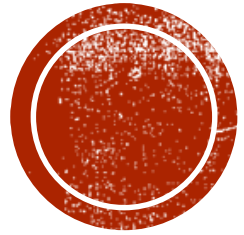
- He sees our affliction.
